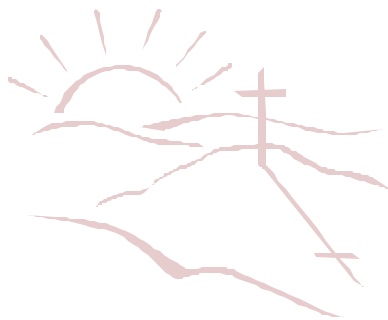

## WARNING: FRIENDS OUT OF BALANCE



### NO CONNECTION

#### LONER

one that avoids others;  
one that pursues a  
markedly independent  
course in thought or

- Does not connect with other men.
- Thinks he does not need anyone but himself.
- Is not a friend to his wife or his children.



### WEARS YOU OUT

#### SMOTHERER

to overpower in thought  
or feeling; to provide  
with more than is needed  
or desirable

- Only takes from others in relationships, never gives.
- Is basically selfish and does not care about other people; he feeds on them.

*If there is no soulish connection then there is no reason for living. If the King provides, but never connects, it's no good. If the Warrior protects, but never connects, it's no good. If the Mentor teaches, but never connects it's no good. It is not good for man to be alone! It is the Friend in his chest that gives the King, the Warrior, and the Mentor a reason to exist. If one of the pillars is to stand a little taller, a little straighter than the others, if one pillar must bear a little more of the weight of manhood than the others, it must be the Friend pillar.*
