LETTER FROM REID

GOSPEL UNDERGROUND PODCAST



SUBSCRIBERS | AUGUST 2017 TO AUGUST 2018






OVER THE PAST YEAR

- A generous year end matching campaign again proved essential and fruitful providing close to 50% of direct donations for the year.
- We continue to enjoy serving the Acts 29 US South Central Network in service of church planters. This also provides a helpful consulting stipend to the ministry.
- We had some extra technology expenses associated with the upgrading of our podcasting studio with quality equipment.
- We created some promotional/ marketing gifts for pastors and friends this year that incurred some expense, but has already resulted in multiple new speaking bookings.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

- Benefit costs and structures remain a bit uncertain and challenging for small businesses.
- We are very dependent on strong, year-end giving. Please pray that December 2018 is once again strong.
- We are budgeting \$121,218.00 for the coming year. This is an increase of \$4,308 year over year and consists primarily in cost of living adjustment, travel budget adjustments, and processing fees for electronic donations.

STRATEGIC FOCUS 2018

Reid's strategic objectives and focus for the coming year include faithfulness in current work serving the church as well as expanding new mediums to impact and influence others for Christ and Kingdom.



Enhance and extend the reach of *The Gospel Underground*. Strategically invite a few more guests on this year and continue word of mouth, underground, promotion of the podcast.



Serve our local church as a consultant to help them with back end organization and staffing strategy.



Explore and Extend partnership with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA). This includes serving on the staff of the local high school football team as a character coach to impact young men, partnerships with FCA Wrestling, and investing in local evangelistic and equipping opportunities.



Continue to support and strengthen local churches with retreats, targeted training, equipping, and leadership development. Preach and share the gospel with students through partnered events.
